A BILL

To amend the Constitution Act, 1902.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the “ Constitution Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1922.”

2. Section thirteen of the Constitution Act, 1902, is amended by the addition of the following new subsection:—

(4) Provided further that nothing herein contained shall extend or be deemed to have extended to any contract or agreement for the purchase of any property in the ordinary course of business from any department of the Public Service or for the supply of any services in the ordinary course of business by any such department.
