To provide an account in the Treasury o which shall be carried all repayments of the cost of arrying out works cof water supply and sewerage, and for the application of amoneys at credit of that account.

BEI it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Iajesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Concil and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament asembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. All moneys carried to a loan trust fund in pursuance of subsecction one of section two of the Act fifty-seventh Victoria number nineteeen, and at the commencement of this Act a credit of that fund shall be transferred to a Special Trust Account in the Treasury, to be called the "Water Supply and Sewerage Loans Redmption Fund," and shall be dealt with as hereinafter provided; and any such first-mentioned loan trust fund shall be closed.

All such repayments of the cost of carrying out any works of water supply and sewerage mentioned in the said absection as by the said subsection are directed to be carried to a loantrust account shall, after the commencement of this Act, be carried to the account abovementioned, called the "Water Supply and Sewerage Loans Redemption Fund."

It shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to apply any moneyss at credit of the Water Supply and SewerageLoans Redemption Fund ffor the redemption at maturity of any loansor portions of any loans issued for the construction in pursuance of the Country Towns Water and Sewerage Act of 1880, or any Act amending that Act, of any woorks of water supply or sewerage.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Country Fowns Water and Short title.
