A BILL

To declare certain resumptions and notices of resumptions for purposes of defence to be void and of no effect.

WHEREAS under the Act eighteenth Victoria number ten Preamble. certain lands respectively described in the Schedules to this Act were resumed for purposes of defence, but no compensation was paid in respect of such resumptions, and the said lands were not used for the purposes aforesaid: And whereas it is expedient that such lands should revert to the persons who would be entitled to the same if such resumptions had not been made: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice

advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Defence Lands Revesting Short title. 5 Act, 1901."
 - 2. The said resumptions and any notices of such resumptions Resumptions shall be deemed to have been and to be void and of no effect.

 Resumptions declared to be of no effect.

SCHEDULES.

SCHEDULE ONE.

All that piece and parcel of land near Chowder Bay, containing by admeasurement five and a half acres, more or less: Commencing at the south-east corner of an unsold portion numbered thirteen, and containing six and a half acres; and bounded on the west by a line running north eight chains eighty-five links; thence on the north by a line running east seven chains; thence on the east by a line running south eight chains twenty links to the waters of Chowder Bay; thence on the south by the waters of Chowder Bay and Chowder Creek upwards, to the point of commencement.

SCHEDULE TWO.

All that piece and parcel of land near Bradley's Head, containing by admeasurement four acres, more or less: Commencing at the north-east corner of C. H. Jenkins' 20 forty-five acres; and bounded on the north by a line running east eight chains fifty links; thence on the east by a line running south seven chains to the waters of Taylor's Bay; thence on the south and west by the waters of Taylor's Bay and Taylor's Creek, to the point of commencement.

SCHEDULE THREE.

All that piece of land containing by admeasurement two roods twenty-five perches, parish of Willoughby, county of Cumberland, in the said Colony, part of Mrs. Hanson's four acres, at Bradley's Head: Commencing at the north-east corner of the aforesaid four acres; and bounded thence on the north by part of the north boundary of that land westerly three chains; on the south-west by a line south-easterly to the 30 south-eastern corner of the aforesaid four acres; and on the east by the east boundary of the aforesaid four acres bearing north four chains and fifty links, to the point of commencement.
