A BILL

To amend section one hundred and twenty-two of the District Courts Act, 1912-1932, in certain respects.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows —

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " District Courts Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1934."

(2) The District Courts Act, 1912-1932, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the District Courts Act, 1912-1934.

2. The District Courts Act, 1912-1932, is amended by inserting at the end of section one hundred and twenty-two the following words:—" and a payment by the garnishee to the registrar before the return day of the summons shall be deemed to be a payment made under a proceeding herein provided."
