# A BILL

To amend the Dividing Fences Act, 1902.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the “Dividing Fences Short title.  
(Amendment) Act, 1915.”

**2.** Section three of the Dividing Fences Act, 1902, Amendment  
of s. 3.  
is amended—

(a) by adding to subsection one the following paragraph:—

“The abovementioned requirement shall be made by sending a registered letter addressed to such owner, person, or agent at his last-known place of residence”; and

(b) by omitting in subsection two the words “six months,” and substituting therefor the words “one month”.
