# A BILL

To amend the Early Closing Act, 1899 ; and for other purposes.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the " Early Closing (Amendment) Act, 1910." Short title and commencement.

This Act shall commence and take effect on and from the day of , one thousand nine hundred and

**2.** Subsection one of section one of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the following proviso next before the proviso inserted in that subsection by section two of the Early Closing (Hairdressers' Shops) Act, 1906 :— Amendment of s. 1.

Provided that in respect of such shops situate within the metropolitan shopping district (except shops kept by persons of or over the age of years, or by widows, and in which not more than one shop-assistant is employed, such shop-assistant being a member of the family of the employer) the closing time on Wednesday shall, subject to the provisions of the Early Closing (Amendment) Act, 1900, and the Early Closing (Hairdressers' Shops) Act, 1906, be six o'clock.
