
A BILL

To authorise the sale or disposal of electric power by the Chief Railway Commissioner to certain municipalities within the county of Cumberland; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Electric Power Disposal Act, 1912." Short title.

2. The Chief Commissioner for Railways and Tramways is hereby authorised to dispose of to a council of a municipality or shire within the county of Cumberland, and such council may purchase any electric power which may be available in excess of that required for the efficient working of the railways and tramways. Power of Chief Commissioner to sell and of certain councils to purchase electric power.

3. The terms and conditions on which such electric power shall be supplied shall be as agreed upon between the said Chief Commissioner and the municipality or shire concerned. Conditions of sale.

4. The Governor may by proclamation in the Gazette declare that any municipality or shire in such proclamation mentioned shall be excepted from the operation of this Act, and the said Chief Commissioner shall not be entitled to supply electric power to any shire or municipality mentioned in any such proclamation. Governor may except any councils.
