A BILL

To provide that the payment of family endowment in respect of any period after the next declaration by the Industrial Commission of New South Wales of the living wages for an adult male employee shall be discontinued; to provide for the discontinuance of the imposition of contributions by employers to the Family Endowment Fund; to amend the Family Endowment Act, 1927-1928, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Family Endowment (Discontinuance) Act, 1929," and shall be read and construed with the Family Endowment Act, 1927-1928, as amended by subsequent Acts, which Act as so amended is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Discontinuance of Family Endowment.

2. Upon the declaration next after the commencement of this Act by the Industrial Commission of New South Wales of the living wages for an adult male employee in exercise of the power conferred upon it by paragraph (b) of subsection one of section seven of the Industrial Arbitration (Amendment) Act, 1926, or any other Act, the payment of endowment under the Principal Act shall be discontinued.

This section shall not operate to prevent payments in respect of claims for endowment made or certificates granted or renewed before the date of such declaration, but no certificate shall be issued and no payment shall be made in respect of any period after such date.

Discontinuance of contribution to Family Endowment Fund.

3. Upon a day appointed by the Governor and notified in the Gazette the imposition of contributions to the Family Endowment Fund under the Principal Act or the regulations thereunder or the Finance (Family Endowment Tax) Act, 1929, in respect of wages paid after such day shall be discontinued.
