A BILL

To remove Thomas Treble, Esquire, from his office as Commissioner of Family Endowment ; to amend the Family Endowment Act, 1927, and certain other Acts ; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Family Endow- Short title: ment (Removal of Commissioner) Act, 1927."

2. (1) From the commencement of this Act Thomas Treble, Esquire, shall cease to hold his office as Commissioner for Family Endowment.

(2) The said Thomas Treble shall not be entitled to any damages or to be paid any compensation by reason of his removal from such office.

(3) The office of the said Thomas Treble as Commissioner for Family Endowment shall be deemed to be discontinued within the meaning of subsection eight of section four of the Family Endowment Act, 1927.

(4) From the commencement of this Act until he is appointed to some office in the Public Service in pursuance of the said subsection eight, the said Thomas Treble shall be deemed to be an officer of the Public Service upon leave upon a salary equivalent to that which he held at the date of his appointment as such Commissioner.
