A BILL

To amend the Gaming and Betting Act, 1906.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and Betting Short title.
(Amendment) Act, 1912."

2. Section thirty of the Gaming and Betting Act, 1906, is Amendment of s. 30.
amended by omitting all the words after "Newcastle" and inserting the words "on any day except a Sunday, or Good Friday or Christmas Day."

3. Section thirty-four of the same Act is amended by inserting Amendment of s. 34.
after "situate as aforesaid" the words "Provided that no such meeting shall be held on a racecourse situate within forty miles of the General Post Office, Sydney, on any day fixed by the Australian Jockey Club for a meeting for horse-racing to be held on a racecourse situate as aforesaid."
