A BILL

To amend the Government Savings Bank Act, 1906, the Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913, and certain other Acts ; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Government Savings Bank Amendment Act (No. 2), 1914," and shall be construed with the Government Savings Bank Act, 1906, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.

Short title.

2. (1) Section five of the Principal Act, as amended by section thirteen of the Closer Settlement Promotion Act, 1910, is amended by inserting after the words "and includes" in the definition of the term "Crown Lands Acts" the following words: "the Western Lands Act of 1901".

(2) Section sixty-two of the Principal Act, as amended by the Schedule to the Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913, is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (b) the following words: "(xiii) leases granted under the Western Lands Acts."

(3) Section sixty-eight, paragraph (f), of the Principal Act, as amended by the Schedule to the Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913, is amended by inserting after the words "Crown Lands Acts" the following words: "Western lands lease."

(4) Section sixty-nine, paragraph (a), of the Principal Act, as amended by the Schedule to the Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913, is amended by inserting after the words "Lands Department" the following words: "Provided that in the case of western lands leases such balance shall be paid into the Treasury to the credit of the Western Land Board of New South Wales."

(5) Section 75A of the Principal Act, inserted by the Schedule to the Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913, is amended by inserting after the words "the provisions of" the following words: "the Western Lands Act, 1901".
