A BILL

To amend the Interstate Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1919, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Interstate Destitute Persons Relief (Amendment) Act, 1938." Short title.

Interstate Destitute Persons Relief (Amendment).

2. The Interstate Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1919, as subsequently amended, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 33, 1919.

(a) by inserting in section four in the definition of "State" after the words "the Dominion of New Zealand" the words "and any Territory in respect of which a Mandate is being exercised by the Government of the Commonwealth"; Sec. 4. (Definitions.)

(b) by inserting in subsections one and two of section five after the words "an Act" wherever occurring the words "or ordinance." Sec. 5. (Reciprocity.)
