A BILL

To make provision for the widow and certain children of the late John Storey by grants out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS it is desirable to make provision for Preamble.
the widow and certain children of the late John Storey: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent
5 of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "John Storey Family Short title.
Grant Act, 1921."

Moneys to be
paid to Public
Trustee out of
Consolidated
Revenue
Fund.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor, by warrant under his hand addressed to the Colonial Treasurer, to direct the payment out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Public Trustee of—

- (a) the sum of three hundred pounds sterling **5**
yearly, to be paid by the Public Trustee into the hands of the widow of the said late John Storey during her lifetime, without power of anticipation ;
- (b) the several sums of one hundred pounds sterling **10**
yearly during their respective minorities in respect of the two children of the said late John Storey hereinafter mentioned, namely, Elizabeth Merton and Nance, upon trust for the education, care, and maintenance of each **15**
of the said children during their respective minorities, to be applied to those purposes at the sole discretion of the Public Trustee,

and such warrant shall charge the Consolidated Revenue Fund with the payment of the said respective sums and **20**
shall be a discharge for such payment to the said Treasurer.
