A BILL

To prohibit smoking by persons under the age of sixteen years; to amend the Juvenile Smoking Suppression Act, 1903; and for other purposes.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Juvenile Smoking Short title.
Suppression Amendment Act, 1915."

2. The following section shall be inserted and read New
immediately after section one of the Juvenile Smoking section.
Suppression Act, 1903:—

2. Any person under the age of sixteen years Persons under
sixteen liable
to fine for
who—

- (a) smokes tobacco in any form, cigars OR smoking, &c.
cigarettes; or
- (b) has in his possession any tobacco, cigars,
or cigarettes unless he proves to the
satisfaction of the magistrate or justices
before whom he is tried that such tobacco,
cigars, or cigarettes were not for his own
use,

shall be liable to a fine not exceeding *five* pounds.
