# A BILL

To amend the Liquor Act, 1912.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Liquor Amendment Act, 1915." Short title.

**2.** Section fifty-seven, subsection one, paragraph (b) of the Liquor Act, 1912, is amended by omitting all the paragraph after the words "Christmas Day" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Except between the hours of half-past seven and nine in the morning, and of half-past twelve and two in the afternoon, and of half-past eight and ten at night." Hours for sale of liquor on Good Fridays and Christmas Days.
