A BILL

To amend the Local Government Act, 1906; and for other purposes.

[MR. ; — 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Local Government (Amending) Act, 1916." Short title.

2. Section fifty-five of the Local Government Act, 1906, is amended in paragraph (a) by substituting the word "or" for the word "and" after the word "owners," and by omitting the words "and verified by statutory declaration of the terms thereof" Amendment of s. 55 of Principal Act.
