A BILL

To provide for certain payments to the Colonial Treasurer from the County of Cumberland Main Roads Fund and the Country Main Roads Fund; to amend the Main Roads Act, 1924-1931; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Main Roads Short title.
(Funds) Amendment Act, 1932."

2. (1) There shall be paid to the Colonial Treasurer from the County of Cumberland Main Roads Fund for credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, during the financial year commencing on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, on a date to be determined by the Colonial Treasurer, the sum of forty-six thousand pounds.

(2) There shall be paid to the Colonial Treasurer from the Country Main Roads Fund for credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, during the financial year commencing on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, on a date to be determined by the Colonial Treasurer, the sum of one hundred and fifty-four thousand pounds.
