A BILL

To enable the committee of the Maitland Hospital to withdraw certain moneys from its fixed deposit account for the purpose of erecting and furnishing infectious wards.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Maitland Hospital (Infectious Wards) Further Enabling Act, 1914." Short title.

2. The Committee of the Maitland Hospital may, with the consent of the trustees of the said hospital, or of a majority of them, withdraw a sum of money, not to exceed one thousand pounds, from the amount in any fixed deposit standing to its credit, or to that of the said trustees, at any bank for the purpose of, and may expend such money in, erecting and furnishing new infectious wards. Authority to withdraw certain moneys from fixed deposits.

The said sum of a thousand pounds is in addition to the fifteen hundred pounds authorised to be withdrawn and expended under the provisions of the Maitland Hospital (Infectious Wards) Enabling Act, 1912.
