A BILL

To amend the Matrimonial Causes Act, 1899 ; and
for purposes incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “ Matrimonial Short title.
Causes (Amendment) Act, 1919.”

2. Section eleven of the Matrimonial Causes Act, 1899, is amended as follows:—

Subsection one: Omit—

- (i) the words “for dissolution of marriage or” where first occurring;
- (ii) the words “a decree nisi for the dissolution of marriage or”; and
- (iii) the word “three,” and insert in lieu thereof the word “two.”

Subsection two: Omit the subsection.

3. Nothing in this Act shall be deemed to affect any suit for dissolution of marriage instituted before the commencement of this Act.
