A BILL

To provide for the payment of certain moneys to the Municipal Council of Sydney; to relieve the said council of certain liabilities; to provide for the making of certain roads by the said council; to amend the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902, and the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1908; and for purposes incidental thereto or consequent thereon.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Sale-Short title. yards Act, 1918."

2. In this Act unless the context otherwise requires— Definition. "Council" means the Municipal Council of Sydney.

Obligations of the Government.

3. (1) The Colonial Treasurer shall pay into the City Payments to Fund-

be made by Colonial

(a) the sum of six thousand pounds as a refund of Treasurer. money expended by the council in extending the Flemington sale-yards in the years one thousand nine hundred and ten and one thousand nine hundred and eleven;

(b) a sum not exceeding eight hundred and seventynine pounds eighteen shillings and fivepence,

made up as follows:—

These sums shall be subject to adjustment between the Colonial Secretary and the council.

(c) an annual sum not exceeding fifteen hundred pounds for the purpose of lighting the Domain from the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, and all arrears of payment of such sums.

The amount specified in paragraph (a) shall be paid from such Loan Votes as are now or may hereafter be applicable to that purpose, or from appropriations of the Public Works Fund, or partly from such votes and partly from the said appropriations.

(2) The amounts specified in paragraphs (b) and (c) are hereby appropriated from and shall be paid out

of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Obligations of council.

4. The council shall make—

(a) a new street parallel to William-street;

(b) a new street parallel to Sussex-street;

(c) a new street from Cowper Wharf, Woolloomooloo, to College-street. The

New streets to be formed by council.

The position, dimensions, and other particulars with regard to these new streets shall, subject to any Act or Acts relating to the making of new streets, be as agreed upon by the Colonial Secretary and the council.

Amendments of the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902.

5. Sections one hundred and forty-three and one Repeal. hundred and forty-seven of the abovementioned Act are hereby repealed.

Amendment of Sydney Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1908.

6. Sections thirty-six and thirty-nine of the above-Repealmentioned Act are hereby repealed.
