A BILL

To amend section seven of the Metropolitan Traffic Act, 1900, as amended by subsequent Acts, in certain respects; and for purposes connected herewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Traffic (Amendment) Act, 1935." Short title.

2. The Metropolitan Traffic Act, 1900, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting after paragraph (q) of section seven the following new paragraph:— Amendment of Act No. 8, 1900, s. 7. (Obstruction of pedestrian traffic.)

(q1) prohibit the obstruction of pedestrian traffic upon public streets, by displays or exhibitions on any premises abutting on or near any public street.
