## A BILL

To vest certain lands and works and certain property in the Board of Water Supply and Sewerage; to apply the provisions of the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1889, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts Extension Act of 1894 to the water supply of the municipality of Richmond; and to authorise the mayor and aldermen of that municipality to vote at elections of members of the said board; and for purposes incidental to or consequent on those objects.

1. This Act shall be construed with the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1889, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act Extension Act of 1894, and may be cited as the "Metropolitan Water (Richmond) Act, 1900." Incorporation and short title.

2. All lands appropriated, resumed, taken, or acquired for the purposes of the water supply of the municipality of Richmond and vested in the Secretary for Public Works, and all reservoirs, engines, buildings, works, pipes, fittings, material, and all other property real or personal vested in the said Secretary for the said purposes are hereby transferred from the said Secretary and vested in the Board of Water Supply and Sewerage.

Vesting of works in Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Board and application of metropolitan Acts.

3. The provisions of the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1889, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts Extension Act of 1894, relating to the water supply of the city of Sydney, shall apply to the water supply of the municipality of Richmond.

Application of Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts.

4. The mayor and aldermen of the municipality of Richmond shall be qualified as electors of members of the Board of Water Supply and Sewerage during such time as the said municipality is supplied with water from any works of the said board.

Mayor and aldermen to vote in elections of board.
