## A BILL

To sanction the construction of a line of railway from Moon's Siding to Argoon; to amend the Public Works Act, 1912; and for purposes connected therewith.

MR. BUTTENSHAW;—

1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Moon's Siding to Short title. Argoon Railway Act, 1928."

2. The carrying out of the work described in the Work sanctioned. Schedule to this Act is hereby sanctioned.

The plan.

3. The plan of the said work is the plan marked "N.S.W. Railways, Moon's Siding to Argoon—Schedule Plan," signed by the Railway Commissioners for New South Wales and countersigned by the Chief Engineer for Railway and Tramway Construction, endorsed L. 1,702, and deposited in the public office of the said Railway Commissioners.

Cost.

4. The cost of carrying out the said work (exclusive of land resumptions) is estimated at two hundred and fifty-three thousand seven hundred and twenty-two 10 pounds, and such estimated cost shall not, under any circumstances, be exceeded by more than ten per centum.

Line may be constructed on road.
Fencing.

5. The said line of railway may be constructed on or

along or by the side of any road or highway.

6. Notwithstanding the provisions of section ninety- 15, one of the Public Works Act, 1912, the Constructing Authority shall not be compelled, nor shall it be the duty of the said Authority, to make or maintain any fence along the said line of railway for the accommodation of any person, or for any purpose whatsoever; but 20, the said Authority may, in its discretion, make and maintain such fences in connection with the said line of railway as it may think fit.

## SCHEDULE.

This railway commences at a point 2 miles 72 chains south of the Moon's Siding Platform on the existing Narrandera—Tocumwal Railway at 370½ miles from Sydney, via Granville, and proceeds thence in a westerly direction for 6½ miles to Yanko Creek, which it crosses on the south of the village of Cudell; thence westerly crossing Pine Creek at 379 miles 10 chains and Washpen Creek at 380 miles 5 chains; thence westerly to 387 miles 10 chains; thence along the northern side of a road 3 chains wide, which it crosses at 391¾ miles; thence proceeding still westerly along the southern side of the aforesaid road for about 15 miles, terminating at Argoon on the western boundary of Portion 44, Parish of Mygotha, County of Boyd, at 406½ miles from Sydney, via Granville, being a total length of 36 miles, and subject to such deviations and modifications as may be considered desirable by the Constructing Authority.
