A BILL

To vest certain land in the council of the Municipality of Moree as a site for certain buildings, but free from the trusts and conditions now affecting the same; to vest certain moneys and securities and other property in the said council; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

WHEREAS by Crown grant dated the twenty-third Preamble.
day of September, one thousand eight hundred
and seventy-nine, and registered volume four hundred
and sixty-six, folio two hundred and thirty-eight, the land
therein described being allotment number two of section
fifty-two, containing two roods and situate in the county
of

of Courallie, parish of Moree, and town of Moree, was granted to certain persons upon trust to permit and suffer the same premises to be appropriated as a site for the erection of certain buildings for a mechanics institute subject to certain conditions therein mentioned: And whereas it is desirable that the said land be freed from the said trusts and conditions and that such land and any moneys and property subject to such trusts be vested in the council of the Municipality of Moree for the erection thereon of buildings to be used as a town hall, library and reading room, and as municipal offices: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Moree School of Arts Vesting Act, 1919." Short title.

2. (1) The land above mentioned is hereby freed from the trusts and conditions of the said Crown grant and is vested in the council of the Municipality of Moree for an estate in fee simple as the site for buildings to be used as a town hall, library and reading room, and as municipal offices. Vesting of land in Moree Council.

The Registrar-General upon production to him of the said Crown grant shall make a note and entry of such vesting on the said Crown grant and in the register book and thereupon the said council shall be deemed to be the registered proprietor of the said land.

(2) Any moneys and securities for money and other property now held upon the trusts of the said grant are hereby vested in and shall be transferred and assured to the said council upon trust for the erection of the said buildings and for establishing a library and reading room therein. The receipt of the said council shall be a sufficient discharge for the payment or transfer of such moneys, securities or property. Vesting of moneys, securities, or property.
