## A BILL

To make provision for the reduction harbour and light rates on certain ships; for this purpose to amend section sixty-one of the Navigation Act, 1901-1935; and for purposes connected therewith.

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, D by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of 5 the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Navigation short title" (Amendment) Act, 1939."

Upon every such ship em-5 ployed in trading or going between some place in Australia and some place beyond Australia 10

Two pence per ton.

Upon every other such ship Four pence per ton,"
