A BILL

To amend the Newcastle District Abattoir
and Sale-yards Act, 1912.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Newcastle Short title.
District Abattoir and Sale-yards (Amendment) Act,
1921."

(2) This Act shall be construed with the Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards Act, 1912, and any Acts amending the same. The Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards Act, 1912, as so amended is hereinafter called the Principal Act.

2. Section six of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

- (a) In subsection one omit the words "fifty-two" and substitute therefor the words "one hundred and fifty."
- (b) In subsection two omit the words "one pound" and substitute therefor the words "two pounds," and omit the words "thirty pounds" and substitute therefor the words "one hundred pounds."

Amendment of s. 6 of Principal Act.

3. The Principal Act is further amended by the insertion of the following new section after section 12A:—

12B. The board may—

- (1) purchase cattle or meat;
- (2) sell cattle or meat, either on its own behalf or on behalf of any other person, and either wholesale or retail, and for this purpose may purchase or lease a shop or shops;
- (3) undertake the delivery of meat to shops in any prescribed areas of the district and make such charges therefor as it shall think fit, and the board shall have the exclusive right to deliver meat of stock slaughtered at the abattoir to shops within such prescribed areas.

New section added after s. 12A of Principal Act.

Board may purchase and sell cattle or meat.
