A BILL

To amend the Obscene and Indecent Publications Act, 1901.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Obscene and short title.

Indecent Publications (Amendment) Act, 1920."

2. The Obscene and Indecent Publications Act, 1901, Insertion of is amended by the insertion next after section three of next afters. 3. that Act of the following new section:—

3A. The Governor may, by proclamation in the Governormay Gazette, declare any book, paper, newspaper, or proclaim any printed matter of any kind whatsoever, and any be an obscene writing, print, picture, photograph, lithograph, publication. drawing, or representation to be an obscene publication within the meaning of this Act:

Provided that the absence of any such proclamation shall not be a bar to any proceedings under this Act, and the obscenity of any publication may

be otherwise proved.
