### Parliamentary Electorates and Elections (Amendment) Bill, 1943.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This is a Bill to amend the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1941.

The amendment provides for the inclusion of commissioned officers of the Defence Forces of the Commonwealth and personnel officers of the Allied Works Council as authorised witnesses within the meaning of the Act.

The purpose of the amendment is to facilitate the recording of votes by members of the Defence Forces and Allied Works personnel who are situated anywhere in Australia.

# A BILL

To amend Parliamentary Electorates the and Elections Act, 1912-1941, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of 5 the same, as follows:—
