A BILL

To enable a certain Parliamentary Select Committee to sit during the adjournment or prorogation of Parliament; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Short title. Select Committee (Milk Supply for Metropolitan Area) Enabling Act, 1922."

2. It is hereby declared that the Select Committee of the Legislative Assembly appointed on the nineteenth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, to inquire into and report upon the milk supply for metropolitan area, may lawfully sit during the period for which Parliament stands adjourned or prorogued, and do all such things as they lawfully may do while Parliament is in session. 5
