## A BILL

To enable certain Parliamentary Select Committees to sit during the adjournment or prorogation of Parliament; and for purposes connected therewith.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of

5 the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the “Parliamentary Short title. Select Committees (Soldier Settlement and Milk Supply for Metropolitan Area) Enabling Act, 1922.”

**2.** It is hereby declared that the Select Committee of the Legislative Assembly appointed on the twenty-third day of August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, to inquire into and report upon the administration of and conditions attaching to soldier settlement in all its branches, with a view to adjusting grievances and placing such settlement on a satisfactory basis, and the Select Committee of the Legislative Assembly appointed on the nineteenth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, to inquire into and report—

- (a) upon the purity and cleanliness of the milk supply of the city of Sydney, and all other municipalities in the metropolitan area;
- (b) what steps should be taken to ensure the purity, cleanliness, and quality of the milk;
- (c) the distribution of the milk, and what further steps should be taken to ensure the clean distribution of the milk—

may lawfully sit during the period for which Parliament stands adjourned or prorogued, and do all such things as they lawfully may do while Parliament is in session.
