A BILL

To authorise and enable the trustees for the time being of the Parramatta District Hospital to sell certain lands situate in Church Street, Parramatta; to provide for the application of the proceeds of sale of such lands; to amend the Public Hospitals Act, 1898; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Parramatta Short title. District Hospital Enabling Act, 1929."

- 2.** (1) The trustees for the time being of the Parramatta District Hospital may, with the approval of the Minister, sell the lands referred to in the Schedule to this Act. ^{Power to sell.}
- 5 (2) Such trustees shall in relation to the said lands be deemed to be trustees for sale thereof, and such lands shall be deemed to be trust property within the meaning of the Trustee Act, 1925.
- 10 (3) The purchase money arising from any sale of such lands shall be deemed to be moneys arising from a donation of real property to such hospital within the meaning of section eighteen of the Public Hospitals Act, 1898, and shall be applied accordingly, or may be paid and applied for the purposes of such hospital in
- 15 such manner as the committee thereof may direct.

SCHEDULE.

20 ALL those parcels of land situate in Church-street, Parramatta, included in Certificate of Title, Volume three thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, Folio fifty-four, of which James Kearney Richard Andrew Phipps Waugh and Walter Sigismund Brown, Medical Practitioners, and George Thomas Erby, Draper, and Peter Morgan, Gentleman, all of Parramatta, are registered as proprietors as joint tenants.
