A BILL

To provide for the transfer of certain surplus sewerage funds from the Council of the Municipality of Parramatta to the Board of Water Supply and Sewerage ; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Parramatta Sewerage Short title. (Surplus Funds) Act, 1919."

2. The sum of two thousand and ninety-two pounds nine shillings surplus moneys derived from the revenue of the Parramatta sewerage works which on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, was in the possession of the Council of the Municipality of Parramatta, is hereby transferred to and vested in the Board of Water Supply and Sewerage, and shall be paid to the said board by the said council within thirty days of the passing of this Act.

Certain surplus moneys vested in Board of Water Supply and Sewerage.

3. In the event of the said council failing to pay the said sum to the board as provided in section two of this Act the Governor shall by proclamation appoint a receiver who shall have all the powers of a receiver appointed under the Local Government Act, 1906, and Acts amending the same, as if the said sum of money were a loan to the said council from the board and guaranteed by the Government, and as if the council had made default in payment of the principal thereof: Provided that no interest shall be chargeable on the said sum.

In default Governor may appoint receiver.
