A BILL

To make provision with regard to statements made and advertisements inserted by certain persons in connection with the sale or purchase of a business; to amend the Police Offences Act, 1901, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Police Offences Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1928."

2. (1) The Police Offences Act, 1901, as amended Amendment of Act No. 5, 1901, by the Police Offences (Amendment) Act, 1908, is as amended by Act No. 12, 1908.

(a) by omitting from section six the words "two sec. 6. pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "five pounds";

(b) by omitting from section seven the words sec. 7. "three pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "five pounds."

(2) Section eight of the Police Offences (Amend-Amendment of Act, 1908, is repealed.
