A BILL

To amend the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1937, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Hospitals (Amendment) Act, 1940." Short title and citation.

(2) The Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1937, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1940.

(a) by omitting from subsection one of section thirty-seven the word "Minister" where firstly occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Colonial Treasurer";

(b) by inserting at the end of the same subsection the following words:—

"A recommendation by the Minister under paragraph (a) of this subsection shall, where the expenditure necessary to carry out the works to which the recommendation relates exceeds two thousand pounds, be made only with the concurrence of the Colonial Treasurer."

(c) by inserting at the end of subsection (3A) of the same section the following words:—

"Any approval by the Governor under this subsection shall be given upon the recommendation of the Colonial Treasurer."
