EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The object of this Bill is to enable the Hospitals Commission to approve of sugreements relating to rates of pay and conditions of employment of hospital employees before such agreements are to have any validity or binding effect.

A BILL

To make certain provisions inrespect of agreements relating to rates of pay and of employment conditions ofemployees; for this purpose to amend the Public Hospitals Act, 1929, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of 5 the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Hospitals Short title, (Amendment) Act, 1953."

- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the twelfth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three.
- (3) The Public Hospitals Act, 1929, as amended 5 by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1953.
