## A BILL

To declare the law with respect to the right to superannuation allowances of certain persons while employed in the service of the State; and for that purpose to amend the Acts relating to the Public Service.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be called the "Public Service Short title. (Superannuation) Declaratory Act, 1918."

**2.** A person to whom a superannuation allowance under any Acts relating to the Public Service was or may be at any time payable shall not be or be deemed to have been entitled to be paid such allowance or any part thereof in respect of any period, before or after the commencement of this Act during which he was or is employed in the service of the State, unless the Governor otherwise authorises by proclamation published in the Gazette:

Where person entitled to pension is employed in Public Service.

Provided that nothing herein shall invalidate any payments already made to any such person.
