A BILL

[PUBLIC SERVICE SUPERANNUATION (LIMITATION)].

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Superannuation (Limitation) Act, 1915." Short title.

2. Where the services of any officer in the Public Service were dispensed with under the provisions of the Act 59 Vic. No. 25, within twelve months from the commencement of the said Act, and such officer was at any time thereafter employed permanently or temporarily in the Public Service of this State or of the Commonwealth, any amount to which he otherwise would have been or would be entitled by way of superannuation allowance under the Public Service (Superannuation) Act, 1899, shall not be deemed to have been or be payable for or during such time as he has been or may be so employed as aforesaid. Super-annuation allowance not payable during term of employment.
