## A BILL

To allow the appropriation of money for public works before the carrying out of such works has been sanctioned under the Public Works Act, 1912; to amend the said Act; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Works Short title.

(Appropriation) Act, 1916."

2. Subsection one of section thirty-four of the Amendment Public Works Act, 1912, is amended by adding thereto of s. 34 (1).

the following proviso:—

"Provided also that nothing in this subsection Appropriashall prevent the appropriation by Parliament of tion for work not money for carrying out any such work before the sanctioned. same has been sanctioned as in this Part provided: But the money shall not be expended on such work until the carrying out of the work has been so sanctioned."
