A BILL

To amend the Public Works Act, 1912.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Works Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1914."

2. Section eighty-two of the Public Works Act, Amendment of s. 82. 1912, is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection two thereof :—

2A. Where it is desired by the Constructing Timber may be taken from lands within fifteen miles of the work. Authority to take timber from any lands for the purposes aforesaid, clause (a) of subsection one of this section shall be read as if the words "fifteen miles" were substituted for the words "two hundred yards" in that clause.
