## A BILL

To amend the Public Works and Closer Settlement Funds Act, 1906, and the Closer Settlement Act, 1904, and for purpose s incidental thereto.

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Works and Short title. Closer Settlement Funds (Amendment) Act, 1915."

- 2. The following enactments of this Act shall be Enactments deemed to have taken effect on the first day of July, retrospective. one thousand nine hundred and fourteen.
- 3. (1) Paragraph (a) of subsection one of section Amendment four of the Public Works and Closer Settlement Funds Works and Act, 1906, is amended by inserting after "Crown lands" Closer Settlement Funds the following words "paid into that account". Closer Settlement Funds Met, 1906.
- (2) Section six of the same Act is amended by Amendment omitting all the words after "all", in second line of of s. 6 (b). paragraph (b), sub-clause (1), and inserting the words "moneys paid into Treasury in pursuance of section forty of the Closer Settlement Act, 1904."
- (3) The unrepealed part of section forty of the Closer Settlement Act, 1904, is repealed, and the following is substituted:—
  - 40. All money received in respect of sales by auction, or of leases or of settlement purchases of—
    - (a) land acquired under the Closer Settlement Acts; or
    - (b) Crown lands included in settlement purchase areas; or
    - (c) holdings under the Crown lands Acts, including or partly including land comprised in leases acquired by the Crown under the Closer Settlement Acts,

shall be paid into the Closer Settlement Fund.

4. Subsection one of section seven of the Public Amendment Works and Closer Settlement Funds Act, 1906, is of Public Works and repealed, and the following is substituted for it:—

(1) Money at credit of the Closer Settlement Act, 1906. Fund may be applied under the authority of an s. 7 (1).

Act of Parliament for—

- (a) the acquisition or disposal or proposed acquisition or disposal of land under the Closer Settlement Act, 1904, or any Act passed, or to be passed, amending the same;
- (b) the cost of all field, office, and legal work of Government departments, and all legal costs, and the cost of the construction of subdivision roads and roads of access, payable

payable by the Crown in connection with such acquisition or disposal or proposed acquisition or disposal; and

(c) such other expense in connection with closer settlement as the Colonial Treasurer may deem fairly chargeable against such fund.

Subsection two of the same section is amended by adding the words:—"The Closer Settlement Fund shall recoup the Consolidated Revenue Account in respect of payments made from that account, in connection with the salaries of members and officers of Closer Settlement Advisory Boards, and other expenses in connection with the discharge of their duties."
