**A BILL**

To make certain provisions in relation to the sale of butter; for this purpose to amend the Pure Food Act, 1908, and the Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1932; and for purposes connected therewith.

---

**BE** it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Pure Food (Butter) Short title. Amendment Act, 1936."

**2.** (1) The Pure Food Act, 1908, is amended by inserting in Part II, next after section twenty-one, the following new short heading and section:—

*Butter.*

21A. (1) A person shall not sell butter unless it conforms to one of the grades for butter prescribed by regulations for the time being in force under the Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1932.

Sale of  
butter.

(2) Where a person sells butter he shall deliver the butter to the purchaser in a package upon which there shall be legibly and durably written a statement setting out—

- (a) the grade of the butter under the name or description specified in relation to that grade in the regulations made under the Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1932; and
- (b) the name and address of the person by whom the butter was manufactured; and
- (c) the place at which the butter was manufactured.

(3) No person shall sell any butter in respect of which the provisions of this section have been contravened or have not been complied with.

(4) This section shall be construed subject to the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act and so as not to exceed the legislative power of the State to the intent that where any provision of this section or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid the remainder of this section and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

(2) The Pure Food Act, 1908, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Pure Food Act, 1908-1936.

**3.** (1) The Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1932, is amended by inserting after paragraph (j) of subsection one of section twenty-five the following new paragraph:—

(j1) prescribing grades for dairy produce.

(2) The Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1932, as amended by this section, may be cited as the Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1936.
