2. Section three of the Railway Service Superannuation Act, Amendment of s. 3

1910, is amended by the addition of the following paragraph:—

"The board may direct its secretary to issue for publication Deliberation of such report of the matters dealt with at any meeting as it may board at meetings to deem advisable. It may also authorise the communication of any other information in connection therewith. Any person who publishes or communicates to any other person, except as above prescribed, any information with regard to the meetings of the board shall be liable for each offence to a penalty not exceeding twenty pounds."
