A BILL

To amend the provisions of the Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1911, relating to the power of the society to mortgage certain lands; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Royal Agricultural Short title. Society (Amendment) Act, 1928," and shall be read with the Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1911.

2. The Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1911, is Amendment amended by inserting at the end of section five the of Act No. 1, following new subsection:-

(2) A mortgagee of the said society where the sale in mortgage.) mortgage is made with the permission of the Minister for Lands, may, subject to the Conveyancing Act, 1919, exercise all or any of the powers conferred on a mortgagee by that Act, and where a sale or lease of lands is made to any person under any such power, such person shall hold the lands free from all trusts and conditions which affected them in the hands of the said society.
