# A BILL

To amend the Act 57 Vic. No. 15; and for other purposes.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Royal Agricultural Society's Short title. Grounds Act, 1910."

**2.** Section one of the Act fifty-seventh Victoria number fifteen is amended—

- (a) by inserting after "vest" the words "and is hereby vested";
- (b) by omitting "for a period of twenty-one years from and after the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four" and inserting the words "for an estate in fee simple";
- (c) by omitting "suspended during such period" and inserting the words "taken away."

**3.** The Preamble of the same Act is amended by omitting from "whereas" to "vested," both words included, and by omitting the word "therefore."
