A BILL

To amend the Second-hand Dealers and Collectors Act, 1906, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- 1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers and Collectors (Amendment) Act, 1929." Short title and commencement.
- (2) The Second-hand Dealers and Collectors Act, 1906, as amended by subsequent Acts, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Second-hand Dealers and Collectors. (Amendment).

(3) The Principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers and Collectors Act, 1906-1929."

(4) This Act shall commence upon a date to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

2. The Principal Act is amended by omitting from the definition of the expression "Second-hand dealer" in section two the words "whether such person deals in any other goods or not" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "or who buys old wares for use in the manufacture for sale or trade of goods of any description, whether such person deals in, buys, sells, or manufactures any other goods or not."
