A BILL

To secure the payment of Sheriff's fees.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Where, in respect of the service or execution of any process, fees would be chargeable under the Sheriff's Fees Act, 1887, there shall be deposited in the sheriff's office, to answer such fees, an amount estimated by the sheriff as the probable amount of such fees; and service or execution of such process shall not proceed unless such amount is first deposited. Deposit to answer sheriff's fees.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Sheriff's Fees (Amendment) Act, 1900." Short title.
