A BILL

To sanction the construction of a high tension electric transmission line from Port Kembla to Kiama; to amend the Public Works Act, 1912; and for purposes connected therewith.

[MR. ESTELL;— *December, 1921.*]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "South Coast Towns Short title. Transmission Line Act, 1921."

2. The carrying out of the works described in the Schedule is hereby authorised, and the Minister for Public Works is authorised to carry out the said works. Works authorised.

3. The cost of carrying out the said works, exclusive of land resumptions, is estimated at thirty-five thousand pounds, and shall not, under any circumstances, be exceeded by more than ten per centum. Cost.

4. Electric transmission lines, conduits, and other works may be placed or carried on, over, through, under, along, across, or by the side of any lands, street, road, bridge, viaduct, railway, waters, or watercourse. Works may be constructed on roads, &c.

5. For the purposes of this Act, but not otherwise, the Public Work Act, 1912, is amended by inserting after section four thereof the following :— Amendment of Public Works Act, 1912.

4A. The provisions of this Act relating to the acquisition of land shall also apply to the acquisition of any easement, right, or privilege in, over, or affecting any land.
