A BILL

To discontinue the Special Purposes (Revenue) Fund; to amend the Special Purposes (Revenue) Fund Act, 1928, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Special Purposes (Revenue) Fund Amendment Act, 1932."

Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
