## A BILL

To amend the State Children Relief Act, 1901.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "State Children Relief (Amendment) Act, 1917." Short title.

**2.** (1) Section four of the State Children Relief Act, 1901, is amended by omitting the word "nine" and inserting the word "twelve" in lieu thereof. The board. Amendment of s. 4.

(2) Section five of the same Act is amended by omitting the word "three" and inserting "four" in lieu thereof. Amendment of s. 5.
