# A BILL

To apply certain sums out of Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund, towards the services of the Year 1955–1956.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled,

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have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Twenty-eight millions eight hundred and ninety-three thousand three hundred pounds, that is to say—

Fourteen millions seven hundred and twenty-one thousand six hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Eleven millions one hundred and twenty-nine thousand two hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of Three hundred and three thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

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Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two millions and eighty-four thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two hundred and thirty-eight thousand one hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of Three hundred and twenty-six thousand two hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

20 Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund. the sum of Eighty-nine thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or 25 following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said 30 Funds the sum so granted to Her Majesty: Be it therefor enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the 35 same, as follows:-

Out of the Government Railways Fund there shall £11,129,200 and may be issued and applied for or towards making may be issued out good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her of the Majesty, the sum of Eleven millions one hundred and Government Railways 15 twenty-nine thousand two hundred pounds to be expended Fund. at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of 20 the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of 25 the year 1955-1956.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there £303.800 shall and may be issued and applied for or towards may be making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to of the Road Her Majesty, the sum of Three hundred and three and Transport and Traffic 30 thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the Fund. rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department 35 of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year **40** 1955-1956.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General £2,084,700 Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or issued out towards making good the Supply so resolved to be of the Metgranted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two millions and Transport 5 eighty-four thousand seven hundred pounds to be ex-Trust General pended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the Fund. financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the 10 Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year **15** 1955-1956.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust £238,100 General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied may be issued out for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be of the granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and 20 thirty-eight thousand one hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the 25 Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure 30 of the year 1955-1956.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund there shall £326,200 and may be issued and applied for or towards making may be issued out good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her of the Majesty, the sum of Three hundred and twenty-six Sydney Harbour 35 thousand two hundred pounds to be expended at the Trust Fund. rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services

Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, subject to the rate of any 5 reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1955-1956.

7. Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund £89,700 there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards may be making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to of the 10 Her Majesty, the sum of Eighty-nine thousand seven Sydney Harbour hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which Trust have been sanctioned for the financial year ended Renewals Fund. thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, to defray the salaries, maintenance and work-15 ing expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and lifty-six, subject to the rate of any reduction that 20 may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1955-1956.

8. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums Treasurer for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such to pay under Governor's proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in Warrant 25 writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and 30 Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund, respectively.

9. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to Treasurer 35 time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by to have him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders, and the receipts to receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall discharge him.
